The Tumaini Fund USA's mission is to help the estimated 200,000 impoverished AIDS orphans in the Kagera region of Northwest Tanzania to survive and become self-sufficient by helping to meet their basic needs such as nutritional support, clothing, housing, mosquito nets, access to clean water & educational opportunities.
