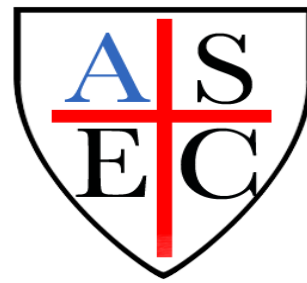
Parish *Information*
